12% refuse to get the vaccine



11% were unsure about receiving the vaccine

Factors Associated with Vaccine Non-Confidence and Refusal



Accelerated vaccine development



Potential side effects



Medical mistrust and past discrimination



Fear of needles



Lack of transport and accessible vaccination clinics

Strategies to Build Vaccine Confidence and Increase Vaccine Uptake

Prioritize 2SLGBTQ+ youth experiencing homelessness

Staff vaccination clinics with trusted 2SLGBTQ+ inclusive and trauma-informed workers

Provide incentives to increase vaccine uptake in a timely manner



Engage peer ambassadors to disseminate youth-friendly vaccine-related information

Educate frontline staff on how to discuss COVID-19 vaccine hesitancy with youth

Ensure youth have accessible vaccination options (location, time of day)
